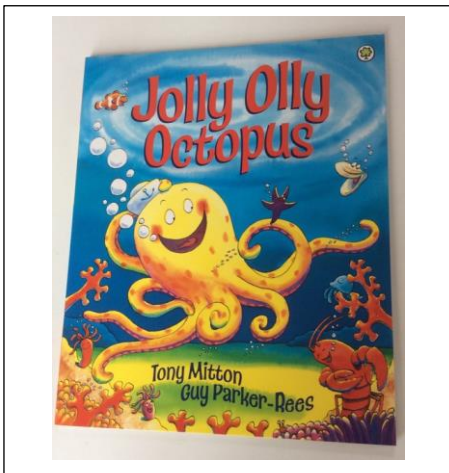


### It's all about rhymes...

I do hope you are all still well and coping with the new regime.

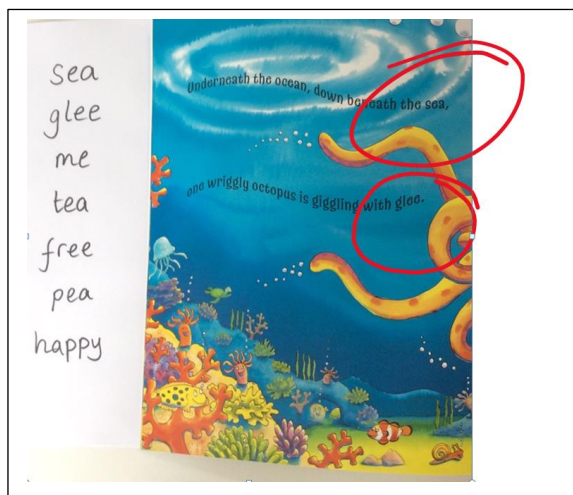
Activities for your children -

This week I thought we could concentrate on rhyming words but additionally, if your child is ready, link it to phonic spelling patterns.



I chose a rhyming book – there are so many to choose from; Julia Donaldson is always a great choice!

Then after you've read the story through, choose a page and ask your child to pick out the rhyming words. Write them on a whiteboard or paper.



You can then ask your child think of other words that follow that rhyming pattern. This is a good opportunity to talk about the different ways a phoneme or sound can be written.
