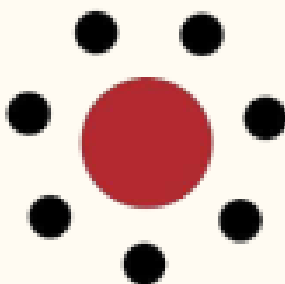

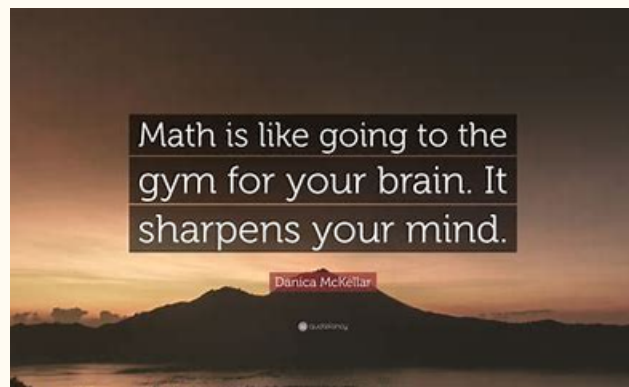


FREE Training
